SFA SPORTS FOR ALL

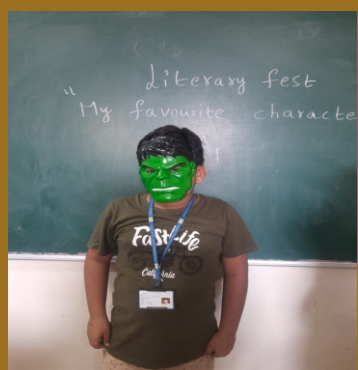

LEARNING THROUGH SPORTS.

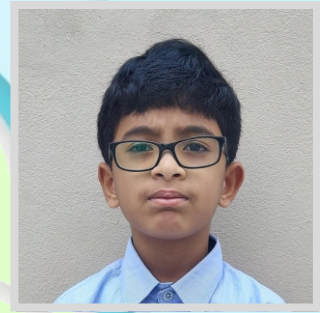
